Course Type	Eligibility Criteria
General Admission Criteria	Applicant must have passed H.S. (10+2)/Equivalent level examination from recognized Board/Council in 2022, 2023, 2024 & 2025
4-Year Undergraduate (B.A./B.Sc.) Honours Courses	- Candidates must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate in the best four subjects (with full marks of 100 each).
	- Candidates must have passed the subject(s) or allied subject(s) at the 10+2 level to opt it as a major/minor subject.
	- The Major subject will be considered as the Honours subject.
Courses with Practical/Project-Based Subjects	- Candidates must obtain qualifying pass marks separately in both theory and practical/project components.
Merit Score Calculation	- Merit score = Total marks of best 4 subjects (with full marks of 100 each) at 10+2/Equivalent level Exam + Percentage marks in the Major subject (or allied subjects as per the table).
